## **August 29, 2007**

### **Meeting Minutes**

In attendance: Vicki Kron, Mo Letteer, Jen Signor, Rose Linton, Nancy Kenney, Andy Morrow, Jon Keagle, Mary Johnson, Loni Johnson, Wendy Shutter, Deb Dupey, Glenda Stermer-Simpson

Called to order: 6:00 p.m.

Read and reviewed last meeting's minutes. Motion to accept by Rose, all approved.

Reading of Treasurer's Report by Rose. Total in account is \$9,803.13 and detailed account balances read for the other team accounts. Grand total after bills have been paid is \$4,036. An older bill dated for June 2007 came in and was paid. The hotdog steamer was purchased. Sam's Club first visit cost \$1,293. We'll need to go back to purchase more water and Gatorade for the bucket game.

Please note that \$800 was transferred to the Babe Ruth Fund after the last treasurers report to correct a missed fund allocation. The track girls and boys fund is together.

Rose was looking into opening an interest bearing savings account but the minimum balance requirement when opening a savings is quite large. It was agreed to put all funds in one savings account and transfer to each checking account as payments need to be made. A spreadsheet will be provided to keep track of all the team funds separately in that account.

\*Special Note: If we purchase 30 cases of Gatorade, we can get a free Gatorade bucket to hold ice and drinks. If anyone buys a case of Gatorade, please save your receipt and give it to Rose.

When we receive donations from outside sources, the donation is deposited into the account that person requests.

Vicki reported receiving \$500 from Sue Bleiler (former 7<sup>th</sup> grade teacher), donated in memory of her parents, to be used toward the concession stand.

Thank you note still needs to be sent to the Anagnost family for their contribution last month. Jen will pick up 2 cards. One also for the Campbell family with a \$50 contribution to the Children's Hospital in Rochester.

Vicki recapped that on the 18<sup>th</sup> the booth was cleaned and old items were discarded and a new labeling system was put in place to help keep organized and make it easier to find things. There is a nice start up and shutdown list posted now to make it easier for volunteers and staff. Mary asks who is responsible for putting flags up and Rose said it is the proctor's job; though it was mentioned if not put out by the proctor we should do it.

Vicki reported that a new roll up steal window has been ordered at a cost of \$850. This door will also be used for the new booth when it is built and has a 25 year guarantee. Red will be putting up new awnings, T1-II, then paint white and maroon. Also he'll put in new counter. Electricity is all updated and we now have a working drain. An 8 gallon hot water tank is still on the list to do.

Vicki reports the first game, boys varsity soccer went great! Concession made \$226. Wendy reported that they sold out of most items. OMSB paid the ball kids \$5 each. Some discussion occurred in regards to this and it was agreed to continue offering this to the kids plus a bottle of water. Maybe ask soccer team to kick in.

Vicki reported that website updates: Entire small fry schedule added. Donations page, Glenda's info and volunteering and score's pages updated. There has been good response with new email and parents/community being interested. Receiving email from people volunteering to work the concession stand. Deb brought promotion magnets with sports boosters name and website; some to be handed out during 6<sup>th</sup> grade orientation.

"Add-A-Year" banner pricing: we have fabric but need to see if we can use it. Jen will give it to Deb.

Flyers handed out on the 13<sup>th</sup> at Junior Varsity and Varsity first day of practice. Flyers to be handed out during 6<sup>th</sup> grade orientation. Also give to Tim Anderson for modified football's 1<sup>st</sup> practice.

Vick reports that game tally, pricing and merchandise lists have been done. Pete doing corn for Saturdays game, desserts, salt potatoes also to be served. Will need to restock for Saturday's bucket game.

Bucket game pep rally agenda updated. Ads placed in the Hi-Lites, Review, on Odessa File and booster site.

Andy reports that band is back together and will meet Friday – will have pep band at 5 p.m., and he will do a little welcome. Would like to see if Jack will say a few quick words. There will be face painting. Deb Stephens will set up at end for admissions. Kids excited and putting up display by auditorium. Rally to be held in gym.

Vicki reports on t-shirts. Also looking into sweatshirts. Showed logo designs – logo was voted on and the design will be tweaked with comments taken into consideration.

Odessa football will be aired tomorrow night on the 6 p.m. news, Channel 18.

OM blankets will be here for bucket game.

Next meeting falls on October 10<sup>th</sup>, with is a modified football game. We'll email the next meeting date and time it is changed. Meeting adjourned 6:43 p.m. Jen motioned, Vicki seconded.
